If 1 ATTEMPT hires or assigns a new instructor to teach the course, 1 ATTEMPT's Continuing Education Coordinator must provide the name of any instructor who will be instructing the course to the Commission within 10 days of employment or assignment. Per Commission Rule 58H .0403, the Continuing Education Coordinator is responsible for ensuring continuing education elective courses are taught by instructors who meet the requirements set forth in Rule 58H .0407.

Sponsors are required to notify the Commission of a scheduled course not later than 10 days prior to the course date using the Sponsor Login page on the Commission's website (www.ncrec.gov).

Approval of the course(s) is effective immediately and expires June 30, 2020 unless renewed prior to that date. You may renew the courses between May 15 and June 30 using the Sponsor Login page on the Commission's website (www.ncrec.gov). Renewal fees apply. Please see Commission Rule 58H .0406 for requirements concerning renewal of course approval.

Commission rules in Sections .0400 of Subchapter 58H impose specific responsibilities on approved course sponsors. Please review these rules carefully prior to offering or conducting a course.
